About us

Mission: The mission of FSS is to train students for the application of knowledge and skills acquired at the Faculty, leading and developing security-criminal activities, solving security-criminal problems in an efficient way.

Vision: The vision of the Faculty is to provide highly qualified personnel for work in all agencies at the level of the Republic of Srpska and BiH and the development of the Faculty in the direction of ecological, energy, economic and industrial security.

The Faculty of Security Studies of the University of Banja Luka started operating on March 6, 2017. The decision of the Government of the Republic of Srpska was transformed by the High School of Internal Affairs into the Faculty of Security Studies. In the past 15 years, the High school of Interior has been conducting a curriculum for training highly qualified personnel for work in police structures, primarily in the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republika Srpska and other police agencies in BiH. As higher education represents a process that is continually changing and upgrading in accordance with the economic, technological and scientific development of society, the need has emerged that the education of future security personnel is set to a higher level, transferred from the Ministry of Internal Affairs and adapted to modern security challenges. For this reason, the Government of the Republic of Srpska has decided to establish a Faculty of Security Studies that will continue to educate personnel for the needs of the police, civil security and the complete security sector, both state and non-state.

In academic 2019/2020 the program of the Faculty of Security Studies will be conducted at the study program Security Science and Criminalistics - 240 ECTS and at the second cycle study program Disaster Risk Management - 60 ECTS.
